Aiming for the Iconic

Quite adept at knocking off tall poppies in New Zealand, global giant Pernod Ricard took a bold step forward with their project to create a top-notch Kiwi white wine that could stand proudly alongside the world's best. The choice of grape variety was, to them, somewhat obvious; hit the pavement in most places and ask what wine New Zealand makes, and the immediate reply is 'Sauvignon Blanc, what else?' However, they do acknowledge considering other options, and it's worth noting that our Riesling and Chardonnay also stand tall these days.

A project many years in the making, the Brancott Estate Chosen Rows is an exceptional expression of Marlborough, and quite unlike anything else we've become accustomed to. Persistently restrained and elegant, it is, quite frankly, rather brilliant. There was much discussion among the team here prior to tasting it, our potential cynicism possibly coming from the endless comparisons with the world's great wines made from Sauvignon, and the lavish hype that Pernod's marketing department propelled into the atmosphere.

At the end of the day though, it's what's in the bottle that counts, and this one does. When earlier in the year we had the opportunity to taste the Chosen Rows with Pernod's Chief Wine-maker, we have to confess to being fairly impressed; this is a great white wine, and distinctively Kiwi to boot.

There is only a small amount made, all individually numbered and packaged. It is, indeed, a superb Sauvignon Blanc that has the capacity to age very gracefully. An excellent corporate gift and a must-have cellar buy.

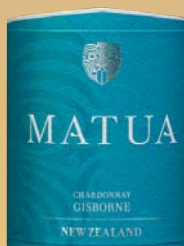

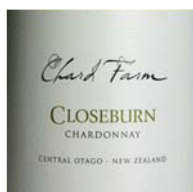
Encouraged by the endeavours of Central Otago's first winemaking pioneers, and against all rational advice, Rob Hay in 1987 planted out his newly acquired Chard Farm orchard – established by Richard Chard in the 1870s – in grapes, in the process neatly turning it into a vineyard, something we're fairly sure he'd secretly always wanted to do.

Carved into the hillside within a breathtaking landscape, it's hard to imagine how you wouldn't just get up every morning and go fishing. However, the Hay family have seemingly overcome that obstacle and gone on to create some of the region's finest vinous expressions. Rob Hay puts it thus: 'It was in hindsight a big gamble, but it sure as hell felt right.' And, even more succinctly: 'Thank God for Pinot Noir.'

Today Chard Farm owns five sustainably managed vineyards in the Gibbston Valley and Lowburn/Packburn sub-regions, planted mainly in Pinot Noir, with a helping of Chardonnay, Riesling and Pinot Gris. The vineyards provide winemaker John Wallace with premium fruit for his blended and single vineyard expressions. With a well-established global reputation for excellence, Chard Farm is considered one of Central Otago's most accomplished wineries.

CHARD FARM CLOSEBURN CENTRAL OTAGO Chardonnay 2012

A fine unoaked Chardonnay, cool-fermented to retain freshness and lees-aged to add complexity. Aromas of nectarine, peach, lemon and cream entice the nose with an appealing earthiness, while the soft and round fruit flavours are enhanced by a nutty, slate-tinged complexity and an elegant citrus and mineral finish.

CHARD FARM RIVER RUN CENTRAL OTAGO Pinot Noir 2011

Here are a few of the better ones.

KUMEU VILLAGE KUMEU CHARDONNAY 2010

Tips its hat to Burgundy and its classification levels, as well as that style of Chardonnay, the one that inspired Michael Brajkovich. There's an undeniable minerality, balance and winemaking prowess at work. While this is Kumeu River's first rung on the quality ladder, there is very little that's 'entry level' about it.

MAN O' WAR EXILED PONUI ISLAND PINOT GRIS 2012

Off-dry and single vineyard, with said vineyard located on Waiheke satellite, Ponui Island; so yes, limited and quite rare are the grapes for this little gem. Pear and ginger caress the ripe fruit flavours, which are given a final cheeky squeeze by a salacious touch of citrus. A popular drop with our regulars for some time now.

SOHO REVOLVER 2011 WAIHEKE MERLOT MALBEC CABERNET FRANC

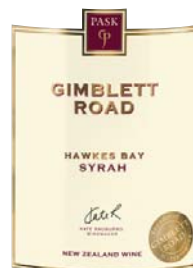


BROOKFIELDS ROBERTSON HAWKES BAY PINOT GRIS 2012

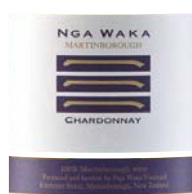

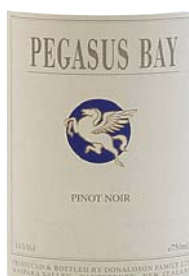

California is the largest and most important wine region, with 90% of its production making up 60% of the US wine consumed within American borders. We have collated here a number of the state's top producers and their varying styles; yes, there are still the boisterous, high-alcohol expressions present, but you'll encounter, too, some exceptionally well balanced and integrated wines.
