

Schloss Vollrads

Germany's Riesling Royalty

Schloss Vollrads is one of the world's oldest wineries. It has been in continuous operation for longer than any other estate, with one of its vineyards mentioned as far back as 850 years ago. Records found at the estate notate wines being sold to nearby Monks in 1211. And the record book doesn't close there: the term *Kabinett* was first used by Schloss Vollrads in 1716, in reference to the winemaker's top selection from that year, making it the first ever official classification of wine in the world.

The estate is situated on Germany's Rhine River in the wine region of Rheingau. Under the guidance of Dr Rowald Hepp, the Schloss Vollrads team apply a searing focus to just one variety, producing Riesling in its myriad forms and nothing else. Running the whole gamut of styles, 60% of production at Schloss Vollrads is dry, and always has been.

The wines are elegant and complex, combining the finest soils and climatic conditions with a profound understanding of Riesling and a huge legacy of winemaking nous. All are fermented in stainless steel and made with minimum intervention, harnessing the magic found in the deep and chalky Rheingau soils, warm, mineral-rich and graced with many different layers of loam, sand and gravel as a result of their ocean- and mountain-influenced formation millons of years ago.

The Prädikat Scale

Prädikatswein constitute the top level of German wines, displaying a *Prädikat*, or ripeness level designation, on the label. They range from dry to intensely sweet. Their designations are as follows, in order of increasing sugar levels in the grapes at the time of harvest.

Kabinett The start of the scale. Grapes must be harvested at 67-82 Oechsle (the scale designating sugar content). Kabinett wines tend to be lighter and more delicate, and can be anything from dry to sweet in style.

Spätlese The next level up, Spätlese means late harvest, with a later picking picking time than for the Kabinett. The Oechsle requirement is 76-90. With the later harvest comes richer, broader, more concentrated wines, though Spätlese, too, can vary in style from dry to sweet.

AUSIESE Adds another factor into the mix: botrytis, also known as noble rot, responsible for concentrating the grape sugars and creating some of the greatest sweet wines in the world. Hence the Auslese wines tend to be even more honeyed and bold in style.

Beerenausiese Taking things to the next level, this involves carefully selecting individual berries with botrytis, so it's similar to an Auslese in sweetness, but with the added focus on fruit selection bestowing even more concentration and richness.

Trockenbeerenauslese The fifth level on the scale, made from grapes that have been left out to mature until they are pretty much raisins hanging on for dear life to the vine. The weather conditions don't allow for this every year, making these very rare, and costly, sweet wines.

Eiswein Icewine. The crown jewel in the range. The grapes must be harvested at -7°C and pressed while they're frozen. Only in exceptional years when the weather conditions line up can these wines be produced. As the sweetness is achieved by freezing the grapes, both the sugar and the acidity are retained, producing wines of impeccable balance and finesse.





BOURGOGNE 2017

Off four vineyards outside the village of Vosne-Romanée, and a good introduction to the current Lamarche style of gentleness and elegance.

VOSNE-ROMANÉE LES CHAUMES 2017

A wine of great finesse, where the oak forms a steadying framework without dominating. Here, it is the supple and generous red fruits and the seductive mouthfeel that command attention.

ÉCHEZEAUX GRAND CRU 2017

The 2017 embraces the Lamarche philosophy of fashioning delicious Burgundy wines that can be enjoyed rather than hoarded away as an investment. Impeccably made, superbly drinkable.



One of Burgundy's oldest estates, Domaine Lamarche is located in Vosne-Romanée, where the Lamarche family settled in 1740. Since its creation, the domaine has been run by successive generations of the family. From 1985, it was under the guidance of François Lamarche, who with his sister, Geneviève, owned the vineyards. Carefully managed over generations, the Lamarche vineyard portfolio includes a selection of parcels in Grand cru appellations Clos de Vougeot, Grands-Échezeaux and Échezeaux, plus four Premier crus in Vougeot-Romanée and one in Nuits-Saint-Georges. The jewel in the crown is their Monopole Grand cru vineyard, La Grande Rue.

François retired in 2006, and his daughter Nicole took over the management of the viticulture and winemaking. Geneviève's daughter, Nathalie, runs the commercial aspects of the domaine. The two cousins have made a number of profound changes that have injected new life into the family business, implementing an organic viticultural regime and restricting yields in the vineyards. They have as well made major investments in the winery, upgrading equipment and adjusting oak aging to better reflect the individuality of each vineyard and vintage.

Bottled without fining or filtration, the Lamarche wines display a lush, shimmering flamboyance and great sophistication, where subtlety trumps power. Under Nicole's astute hands, the quality and consistency of the wines have been significantly lifted, the Lamarche women transforming their legacy into one of Burgundy's top domaines.

Domaine Séguinot-Bordet Depuis 1590



Currently working the 13th generation of the family business, Domaine Séguinot-Bordet have been producing wine in the commune of Maligny since the 18th Century, with records showing the family's roots in Chablis stretching back as far as 1590.

The man currently in charge, the brilliant Jean-François Bordet, has forged a wonderful union between the old and the new and taken his family house to another level. Jean-François has installed a brand new winery in Maligny and established a strict viticultural regime in the vineyards, with cropping levels reduced and the Chardonnay harvested later. With the exception of the Grand Cru, all the wines are cool fermented and matured on lees in stainless steel to achieve fresh, clean fruit underscored by the minerality that characterises the classic Chablis style.

The estate's signature Chablis comes off the Premier Cru vineyard Fourchaume, which they part own. With demand for their product at an all-time high, Séguinot-Bordet have had to start allocating their elegantly expressive, benchmark wines.

Hawkes Bay Original

Some of our most interesting wineries are small hands-on operations, lacking in the fanfare associated with our bigger players, but quietly turning out excellent wines year after year and attracting a dedicated following in the process. Tucked away inconspicuously in the hills above the Napier-Taupo road is one of Hawkes Bay's most individual boutique wineries. Eskdale Winegrowers was established by Canadian ex-pats Kim and Trish Salonius. They arrived in New Zealand in the 1960s, wasting no time in immersing themselves in the burgeoning wine industry that was just beginning to find its feet.

Kim is decidedly in the hands-on camp; he makes the wine himself, largely from the vineyard he and Trish planted in the 1970s, and back then he built a small winery featuring old timbers, arched brick doorways and stained glass. Allowed to ripen to very advanced levels, the grapes are hand harvested, matured in 500-litre oak barrels and bottled at least two or three years after harvest. Kim likes to hold his wines back for a few years before letting them out into the world. One of the Bay's unsung heroes, he avoids the limelight, preferring to stay at home working on his craft and turning out his small range of superb and singular wines.

The Babich Family does Organic

The Babich family are justly proud of their contribution to our winemaking history. Croatian immigrant Josip Babich joined his brothers in Northland's gumfields in 1914. In 1916, he produced his first vintage in Kaikino, and when the brothers moved to a 24-hectare property in Henderson, Josip planted a vineyard. Since then, Babich Wines have evolved to become one of NZ's largest and most respected familyowned wine companies, vineyards in Hawkes Bay and Marlborough augmenting the home vineyard in Henderson. The Babich complex in Henderson was followed by a state-of-the-art winery in Marlborough.

Committed to sustainable practices across their vineyards, Babich were the first in New Zealand to achieve sustainable registration. At their Headwaters vineyard in Marlborough, Babich took the next step, and since 2009 the organic vineyard has been BioGrow-certified. Headwaters is one of the largest BioGrow vineyards in the country, delivering Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Albariño and Pinot Noir under the Babich Family Estates label. With more than 100 years of winemaking experience in their DNA, the Babich family show no signs of abandoning their upward trajectory any time soon.



A tip of the hat to Jackson Estate founder, John 'Stich' Stichbury. The Stich is superbly fresh and aromatic, the vibrant stonefruit, melon and citrus flavours enhanced by a textural backbone, balanced acidity and a lingering pure, mineral-edged finish.

Taking on the World

Jackson Estate have an almost unparalleled affinity with Marlborough, their connection stretching back over 160 years. John and Warren Stichbury, great grandsons of Adam Jackson, after whom Jacksons Road is named, established the winery's first vineyard in 1988.

Pedigree aside, their vision and determination has resulted in the creation of a collection of outstanding wines and is shaping an exciting and progressive future. Surviving the travails that life throws at any winery operation is no mean feat; to do so and remain firmly in private hands is testament to the grit of those involved.

This is still very much estate-made wine, the fruit sourced from three company-owned sites in and around Marlborough: Homestead in the Wairau Plains, and Eversley and Somerset in Waihopai. Chardonnay, Riesling, Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc pour forth from the modern winery complex helmed by winemaker Matt Paterson-Green.

Matt puts it thus: "Our winemaking is not recipe winemaking. We utilise intelligent parts of technology while still maintaining a traditional approach, to produce wines that are a true expression of our vineyards and the region." Whatever they're doing, it's working, with Jackson Estate stepping up on the world stage to take out the 2019 trophy for the top Pinot Noir at the International Wine & Spirit Competition in London.


MOËT ICE



Garrison Brothers

Garrison Brothers is one of the rare bourbon whiskeys made outside of Kentucky or Tennessee. It was, in fact, the first *legal* bourbon distillery in Texas, and until recently, it was almost impossible to find a bottle outside the State. In 2005, Dan Garrison purchased a small ranch outside the city and started building his own distillery. The first batch was not a success. The scorching 54-degree Texas heat destroyed the barrels. They cracked, leaked, and some broke altogether, in the process losing hundreds of gallons. Dan's spirit was stronger than his casks though, and he eventually found a cooperage in Minnesota that was willing to form custom barrels for him. It then took years of trial and error, involving more than 50 different recipes, to perfect the bourbon, with numerous trips to Kentucky to learn from expert producers.

The final result is made from organic Texas-grown corn and wheat, sourcing limestone-rich rainwater from the distillery rooftop. It stands out for its use of a far more expensive fresh sweet mash for each batch, rather than the usual multi-year sour mash. Over at least three years in oak, the extreme heat forces the bourbon further into the wood's crevices than it does in Kentucky, extracting more sugars and colour from the pores. They vary the mash bill and alter the distillation proof each season, meaning every vintage is unique and individually labelled. They're not that concerned with consistency, because consistency is boring.

Each spring, Dan recruits local volunteers, to help him bottle the latest batch in between rounds of shots. They wax dunk each neck and stamp the top with the iconic Texas Star logo. Once inspected and polished, the bottle number is handwritten, and each one is hand-signed with a silver marker. Dan's special batch 'Cowboy Bourbon' has now been Jim Murray's American Whiskey Of The Year *twice*. Everything is bigger in Texas, and it's safe to say Garrison Brothers is living up to that reputation.

The Rise of New Zealand Gin

Of late, gin seems to have taken a page from rosé's current playbook and exploded onto the local scene, even adopting its vinous sibling's rosy hues at times. With the popularity of gin at an all-time high, a dedicated group of New Zealand craft gin producers have concluded that it's their time to shine, putting their time and money on the line to produce highend, small-batch gins that are making the world sit up and take notice.

The French concept of 'terroir', where place of origin is an integral and critical factor in the make-up of a wine, has been embraced by other disciplines - craft beer, for instance - and with gin itself a natural spirit infused with botanicals, the notion is equally applicable. Thus, a gin handcrafted in New Zealand is intrinsically Kiwi in its subtle nuances, which means that these NZ-made gins can invoke the provenance of their home turf via pristine, locally-sourced ingredients. When combined with fastidious production standards, it makes for a whole new industry showing signs of immense potential.

With native botanicals and water sources varying from town to town and region to region, there are some singular expressions appearing up and down the country. These are excellent gins by anybody's standards; but don't take our word for it, try them for yourself.

The Vergnano **Family** Do Super Premium Italian Gin

While popularly thought of as a Dutch invention, it is in Italy that the true origins of gin can be found. From as far back as the 11th Century, Italian monks made a crude spirit infused with juniper, eventually even coming to believe in it as a medicine to combat the Black Death.

This long tradition of distillation was still in practice when, in 1906, Fratelli Ferrero di Riccardo, a family from Piedmont established in the wine and vermouth business, founded a distillery in Moncalieri, just outside the city of Torino. The distillery was purchased in 1992 by Carlo Vergnano and remains a family-owned operation run by Carlo, his wife Piera and their daughter Rita.

Since then the distillery's brand, Malfy, has become internationally famous for its range of premium gins. Malfy now produces four superb spirits: the Originale (think traditional dry gin), the Con Limone (made using a citrus extract, this is gin meets limoncello), the Gin Rosa (Sicilian pink grapefruit) and the Con Arancia (Sicilian blood orange).

Different botanicals are utilised across the range, but it is the lemon sourced from the stunning Amalfi Coast that gives the company their name and the gins their defining quality. Citrus forward, bright and fresh, these are quintessential gins to sip on a hot summer afternoon. DL

McLeod's

Within the historic town of Waipu lies a boutique, independent brewery. When you think of Waipu, its iconic Pizza Barn may spring to mind, but with a reputation for making good beer under its belt, McLeod's Brewery is changing that.

Brothers Geoff and Clayton Gwynne started McLeod's back in 2014, when they decided to brew their own beer for the Pizza Barn, which, incidentally, they had owned since 2003. Their aim was to produce world-class beers that offered a sense of place from their little slice of heaven in Northland, and to say they have succeeded seems like an understatement. Winning several major awards over the past few years, including Champion International Small Brewery at this year's Australian International Brewing Awards, the world's biggest beer competition, and taking out the trophy for Best Amber/Dark Ale as well, they had a lot to celebrate when they turned five last month.

Head brewer Jason Bathgate has been with McLeod's since 2016, building a solid reputation for his dexterity with a range of beer styles. Passionate about mixed ferment and barrelaged brews, his barrel program has amassed a serious following.

The artwork for the McLeod's seasonal brews is painted by grammy-nominated visual artist Sarah Larnach, whose watercolours bring the McLeod's beers to life on the bottle. The Far North Chili Pils features her work. About to be re-released, it is a great example of McLeod's Northland style, with Kaitaia Fire Chili Pepper Sauce added during the brewing process. Refreshingly dry and drinkable with balanced heat, it's a good partner to local northern fare. MR

Garage Project & Day & Dead

Mexico is home to one of the globe's oldest and most diverse food cultures, with roots in the Old World, via Spain, and the even more ancient Aztec and Mayan cuisines. The Mexican national holiday *Dia de los Muertos* is a unique opportunity to experience how these disparate roots combine to create a uniquely Mexican experience. A day of remembrance for those who have passed, it is also a celebration of Life, where the macabre is transformed into the festive.

Since 2011, Garage Project have made a range of beers celebrating Day of the Dead using distinctive Mexican ingredients. Their flagship Day of the Dead beer is inspired by the Aztec spicy hot chocolate beverage, Xocolatl. Garage Project make a black lager with cacao, smoked chipotle chilli, vanilla pods, agave syrup, and cacao nibs. It has a restrained heat that builds as you drink.

La Calavera Catrina is embraced as a Mexican image of Death, the skeleton woman wearing a fancy hat embodying its bitter sweet nature. The Garage Project salute to her is a blonde maize lager with generous habanero chilli notes balanced with the sweetness of rosewater and watermelon.

Triple Day of the Dead is the original recipe brewed strong, with additional flavourings. It is then aged in tequila barrels for up to a year. Try these beers paired with carnitas wrapped in a real corn tortilla doused in lime. TM

To this day, Waimatao continues to rave about Sierra Nevada Pale Ale ('Only \$20 a dozen!'). Eventually, George and Waimatao made it to Canada.

Their memories of America, however, sowed a seed, which sprouted into the aspiration to have their very own microbrewery. The duo eventually returned to George's home town of Paraparaumu with another dream, one of starting their own family. A compromise had to be made, which turned out to be quite an easy one: why choose at all? And like clockwork, Duncan's Brewing Company was opened just down the road, a commute most city folk can only dream of.

Recipes are explored and critiqued, sometimes using American hops in homage to the inspirational trip. The experimental side has also grown. At Beervanna this year, Duncan's Raspberry Ripple Ice Cream Sour was rated 2nd by thirsty patrons, and rumoured to be brewing for another release, along with two new flavours. WM


